## **City Meet Sign Ups Continue**

Registration for City Meet will be done differently in 2010 than the normal dual meets. This year, if you are swimming, there is an \$8 entry fee. Also, GKAIISA sells parking passes and t-shirts, and the Dolphin swimmers can personalize their city meet swim cap.

Here's what you need to know. All swimmers will receive a city meet swim cap if they swim City Meet. However, if you want it personalized with their name, you must send in your [City Meet form](#) by June 30.

If you don't want the personalization on the swim cap, [entry forms](#) are due July 12. A picture of the shirt can be found in the entry form as well. All checks should be made out to MAFD. If you have any questions, ask a board member.
